Dear IAWN steering committee,

I would like to express my sincere intention to join the International Asteroid Warning Network (IAWN) and to bring my modest contribution.

Landehen observatory is a private amateur observation station located in France, in a small village in Bretagne (Britanny in english): code IAU Z43 assigned in 2017.

My primary aim is providing consistent astrometric data of newly discovered NEA (sources: near earth objects coordination centre, NEOfixer, Minor Planet Center) and follow up of objects placed in the near earth objects confirmation page (neocp).

My observatory is equipped with a 0,25m f/4,7 newtonian telescope, a Watec 910 hx/rc video camera connected to a video time inserter (with GPS receptor integrated). I can reach about 19 magnitude.
